SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD will be celebrated this weekend the 25th / 26th January - the 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, with special emphasis on the importance and significance of the word of God.

DEBRA IRELAND. EB (EPIDERMOLYSIS BULLOSA)

This Sunday 26th January: special parish day of awareness and fundraising for DEBRA Ireland. EB (epidermolysis bullosa) is a condition that affects the body's largest organ; the skin. People living with EB are missing the essential proteins that bind the skin's layers together, so any minor friction, movement or trauma causes it to break and blister. It's debilitating. Excruciating. Relentless. A disease with no known cure.

We will have a collection box at all Masses this weekend for donations.

Also, as in the previous two years, we will show a film in the afternoon in the Parish house for those free to attend. This year the film is "The Miracle Club" with Kathy Bates and Maggie Smith. It concerns a group of Irish people who take a trip to Lourdes. It will be followed by some light refreshments. There will also be a donation box for DEBRA at the film.

The shop has re-opened after the Christmas break. New stock will be available for the upcoming liturgical events. We will have a limited number of St. Brigid's lapel crosses available for her feast day on 1 February at a cost of €2 each after all Masses this Sunday. We will have cards, brooches, badges and ribbons for St. Patrick's Day available from week-end of 8/9 February.
