#### **APPOINTMENT TO TURKEY**



Fr David Sánchez (Mexico), has been appointed to the International Omnes Gentes Community in Turkey as from 1 July, 2025. David has been the Society's Novice Master over the past three years.

The hope is that he will join the community in Samsun as soon as visa-requirements allow and start studying Turkish. From its founding in 2023, the community in Turkey has integrated well into the local, largely-muslim context and is gradually broadening its missionary outreach among both local Turkish people, migrants and students.

Susan Illis, the archivist of the Province of the United States, attended the Marist Studies Summer Program in Rome in 2023. She has been researching our former Superior General, Fr. Joseph Buckley sm and has written a 24-page article which

published in the *US Catholic Historian*: "Gentleman Joe: Marist Father Joseph Buckley's World War II Chaplaincy and his service to the Worldwide Church". She points to some features of Fr Buckley's life, noting especially his work as a seminary professor after his doctorate in Rome, his service as an army chaplain during W.W.II where in the Philippines he oversaw the construction of many village chapels, his work in leadership with the Marists in America and in the whole Society. As Superior General (1961 -1969) he was invited to participate in Vatican II where he made a number of notable interventions.
