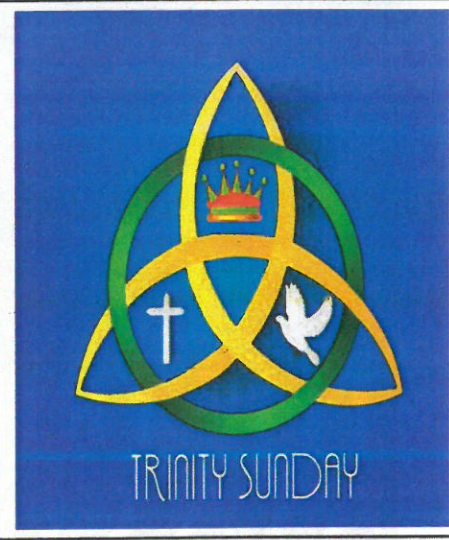
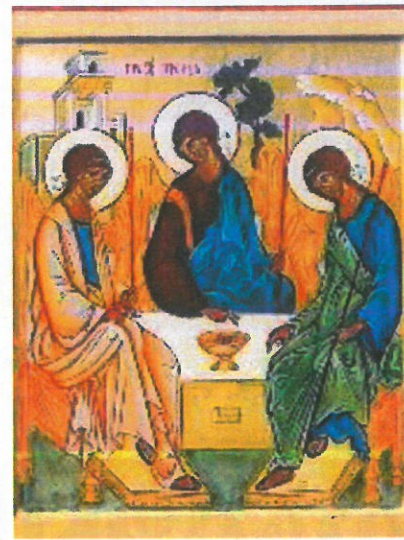

The morning will start with a brief introduction to the history of Cow Parlour, which has been in existence for at least 300 years. We will then be joined by the Lord Mayor, Mr Harrington, who will propose the renaming of Cow Parlour to 'Boulevard Bloom'.
